Fifty Years of Creativity

The Orangeville Art Group (OAG) is a not-for-profit organization. Our mandate is to encourage and promote an appreciation of art, to provide members with opportunities to display their work, to co-operate with other organizations in presenting viewpoints of the art community, to encourage and arrange instruction in art and to provide for contact among members.

Selected works by our members are on display and for sale at the main lobby of the Headwaters Health Care Centre, the Orangeville offices of The Investors Group and the Mill Street branch of the Orangeville Library. These displays are changed every three months to provide visual enjoyment to all visitors. The artists donate 20% from all sales to the Headwaters Health Care Foundation and the Orangeville Library.

The OAG also displays selected art in the Town Hall on Broadway upstairs by the Theatre Orangeville entrance.

The OAG is actively involved in the artistic community and has co-sponsored events hosted by the Dufferin County Museum and Archives.

This year the OAG is able to renew our support of student artists by donating an award for most promising artist to the two Orangeville High Schools and the Shelburne High School. We will also welcome two students from each school to join our Fall Show and Sale.

The OAG provides one-day workshops throughout the year. Instructors are qualified professional artists, who provide a lively and informative atmosphere in which to explore the wonders of painting and sketching. These workshops are open to the public and advertised in the local newspapers.

The OAG also offers paint-alongs, where artists enjoy painting *en plein air* in the countryside of our region with the companionship of fellow artists.

Many thanks to the sponsors listed in this brochure and those from 2009 who have given so generously. We raised sufficient funds in the last two years to have all of our stands refurbished, and they now provide a sturdy support for displaying our art.

The highlight of our year is the Annual Fall Show and Sale, featuring works in watercolour, oil, acrylic, pastel and other mediums. Since 1991, the show was held at the Monora Park Pavilion. However, last year (2010) we moved into a new location which allows more space for more art.

This year will again find us at **The Orangeville Agricultural Centre** (on the Orangeville Fairgrounds) the same weekend as the Home Show in early **October, 2011.**
